### Admission Criteria:

- High School Diploma or HSE (GED)
- TEAS score of a minimum individual adjusted score of 56% or higher
- Application, References, and Physical Exam forms submitted by deadline
- Interview with PN Staff

### Selected applicants must also have:

- No listing on any disqualification lists as required by clinical sites
- Criminal background check

*PN Faculty will evaluate applications based on the selection criteria with input as needed from the program Advisory Committee. The top 24-29 applicants who meet the testing and reference criteria will be accepted and admitted into the program.*

*Clinton Technical School offers TEAS testing for a \$70 fee, payable prior to testing. Study resources may be obtained through ATI at [www.atitesting.com](http://www.atitesting.com).*
